The position is to be filled as soon as possible, with an initial contract duration of eleven(11) months. There are very good prospects for an extension. Employment location will be Bonthe District. The position is paid according to WHH local Salary Grade.

The objective of the position is to provide technical expertise and engineering oversight that ensures effective planning, design, construction, supervision, and sustainability of high-quality WaSH infrastructures, contributing to improved access to safe water, sanitation, and hygiene services for 18 communities across 4 chiefdoms in Bonthe district.

Your responsibilities

The WaSH Engineer is responsible for the technical planning, design, implementation, supervision, quality assurance, and monitoring of water supply, sanitation and hygiene infrastructure and services. The position ensures that all WHH Charity: water funded WaSH interventions comply with national standards, donor requirements, and international best practices while promoting sustainability, community ownership, and climate resilience. Specific tasks include:

- Support field technical assessments and feasibility studies for project interventions.
- Prepare engineering designs, drawings, specifications, and Bills of Quantities (BoQs).
- Ensure designs comply with national standards and international guidelines (e.g., WHO, UNICEF).
- Supervise construction and rehabilitation of Drilled Boreholes and EMAS Pumps
- Ensure work is completed according to approved designs and specifications.
- Conduct routine site inspections and certify completed works.
- Monitor construction quality and compliance with WaSH engineering standards.
- Represent Welthungerhilfe at relevant local level coordination meetings involving local authorities, and other I/NGOs and WASH Cluster.
- Verify contractor performance and adherence to contractual obligations.
- Ensure quality verification of construction materials.
- Maintain comprehensive site documentation and progress records.
- Ensure accessibility (considering persons with disability) and gender-sensitive design of water facilities.
- final inspections and prepare detailed completion activity by activity reports for contracted completion work. Monitor project progress against work plans.
- Prepare technical reports for WHH management and donor.
- Support the technical specifications for procurement
- Coordinate with government ministries, Bonthe district authorities, implementing partners, and communities.
- Participate in district WaSH coordination meetings.
- Support community engagement throughout project implementation.

The WaSH Engineer must have the following qualifications:

- A bachelor's degree in civil engineering, Water Resources Engineering, Environmental Engineering, or a related engineering discipline.
- Master's degree is an added advantage.
- Knowledge of the local language (Mende) is an advantage

- Minimum of **3-5 years** of relevant experience in WaSH engineering.
- Experience implementing donor-funded projects (e.g., AfDB, World Bank, UNICEF, EU, USAID, GIZ) is an advantage.
- Experience in rural water supply systems.
- Experience supervising contractors and construction works.
